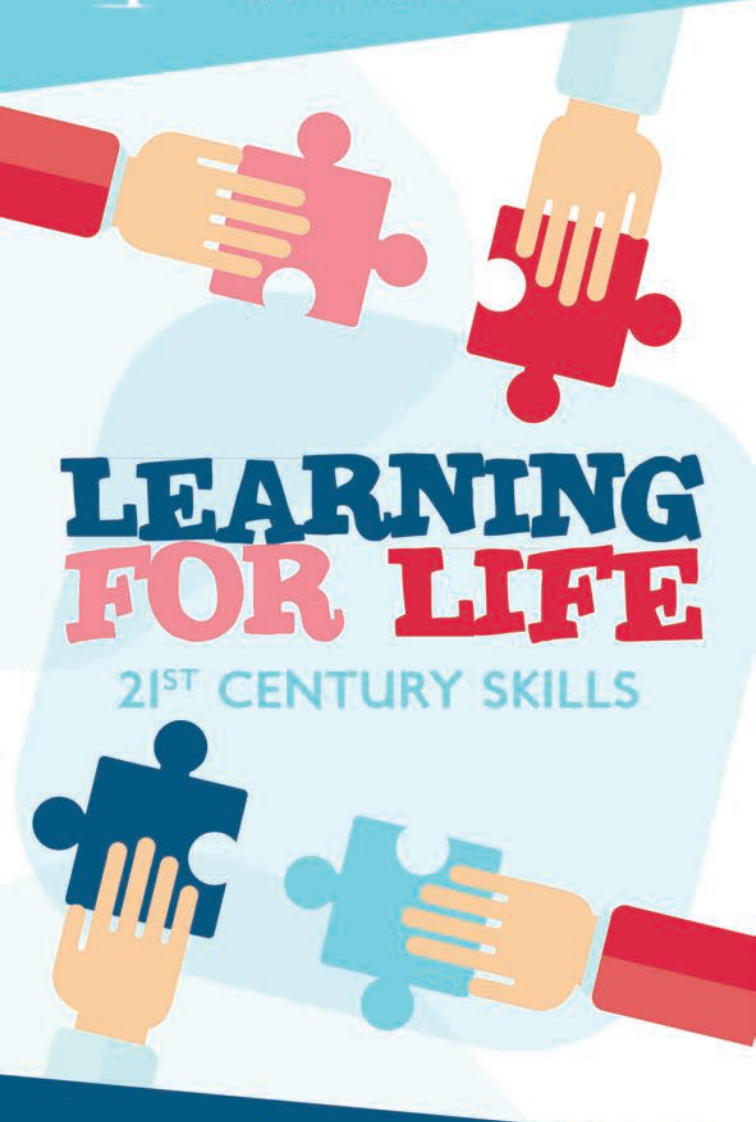

## COMMUNICATION

Sharing thoughts, questions, ideas and solutions



## COLLABORATION

Working together to reach a goal - putting talent, expertise, and knowledge to work



## CRITICAL THINKING

Looking at problems in a different way, linking learning across subjects & disciplines



## CREATIVITY

Trying new approaches to get things done

# THE KEY ELEMENTS

## EXHIBITION

This changes the whole pupil perspective of their work, knowing that they will be presenting and defending their Project both to their peers and adults.

## MULTIPLE DRAFTS

Pupils understand that the quality of their work really matters and are provided with the opportunity to draft, comment, share, review and edit at several points throughout the Project.

## CRITIQUE

Formal critique sessions allow pupils to learn from each other's work and from feedback in a structured, safe environment. It also identifies areas where pupils may need more guidance or specific skills.
