#### 1. BASIS OF THE LINDA M. RANDELL SCHOLARSHIP

Faithful to our values (Integrity and Responsibility), we feel committed to inspire and contribute to society from the English Centre (ECI) Educational Project. That is why, the second generation of the Randell family, represented by our General Director, David Randell, launches the "Linda M. Randell Scholarships (LMR)" created following the The English Centre (ECI) Social Responsibility policy and in order to keep the memory of our founder alive. These scholarships reward and give the opportunity to participate in the ECI educational project to those Pupils with excellent academic records, always in the broadest sense, the holistic sense, and that is aligned with the Values and the profile of the ECI Pupil.

The scholarship is aimed at Pupils of the English Centre as well as to Pupils of other schools and will begin in Lower Sixth Form and for the two school years of the Sixth Form Stage.

#### 2. SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

- 1. Candidates must be Pupils currently studying 4th of ESO.
- **2.** The Scholarships, which will be annually granted by The English Centre, will cover the two school years of Sixth Form (1st and 2nd).
- 3. The Scholarships are addressed to\*:
  - **a.** A scholarship for Pupils from the towns of Jerez de la Frontera, El Puerto de Santa María, Sanlúcar de Barrameda, Chipiona and Rota.
  - **b.** A scholarship for Pupils from the towns of Cádiz, Puerto Real, San Fernando, Conil and Chiclana.
- **4.** The LMR Scholarship includes free of charge:
  - **a.** Registration and reservation of a place.
  - **b.** Tuition.
  - c. Dining and school transport services.
  - d. Textbooks.

#### 3. ASPECTS TO BE ASSESSED OF THE APPLICATIONS

- 1. Present an excellent academic record (academic record 45%).
- 2. Personal curriculum aligned with the values, ethical principles, and profile of the ECI Pupil, reflecting matters such as: participation, selection and awards in projects and competitions, interest and successes demonstrated in the fields of music, sport and Sciences and arts. The Pupils who opt for the submission must deliver a first letter of recommendation in which the participations and successes are evidenced, and a second letter of personal motivation (50%).
- **3.** To be able to access this scholarships, as candidates, it is an essential requirement to have an accredited level of English of at least a B2 (5%). Preferably C1.
- **4.** Young people with and inquisitive, innovative and open mind.
- 5. Proposing and leading Pupil School Club.

<sup>\*</sup>The Centre will strive to respect the geographical representation of both areas, but this will depend on the students presented.

#### 4. DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

- 1. Completed application form for the LMR Scholarship.
- 2. Academic record from Senior School (ESO) or a certificate for each Senior School year (ESO), including the average grades for Year 3 (3° ESO) and Year 4 (4° ESO). (Only curricular subjects will be considered for the calculation of this average).
- 3. Official certification of English language.
- 4. Reference letters from the student's parents, their current tutor, and a third person who can provide relevant insights into the student's personality and character. These letters should explain why the student is a suitable candidate for the LMR Scholarship.
- 5. A written composition by the student describing themselves as a person, including their hobbies and interests, what they believe they can contribute to the ECI community, their vocation and aspirations for the future, why they want to receive the Scholarship, and how they believe it will help them in their future.
- 6. All documentation should be sent to the email address info@elcentroingles.es.

In general, for verification purposes, The English Centre may request the original documents. Incomplete information or missing documentation will result in the rejection of the application.

The English Centre requests this documentation solely for the purpose of evaluating the application for the LMR Scholarship. All data and information provided will be treated as confidential, ensuring the utmost discretion and privacy.

The deadline for submitting applications is open until Sunday 10 April 2026.

#### 5. ASSESSMENT AND AWARD OF THE LMR SCHOLARSHIP

The evaluation of the applications will be carried out by the ECI Assessment Team in the first week of May(\*). After analysing the documents submitted by all candidates, the ECI Assessment Team will interview with a number of finalists selected according to the quality and quantity of participants. Subsequently, the Evaluation Team will choose the finalist candidates who will be proposed to the Board of Directors for a final decision. In the last week of May(\*), after the final selection, The English Centre will communicate in writing with the winners and other candidate Pupils to inform them about their results. This ruling will be published later on ECI's website and social networks.

(\*) the dates are indicative for the internal organization of the Centre and may be changed without the need to be communicated to the applicants.

#### 6. RENOUNCING AND LOSS OF SCHOLARSHIP

- **1.** The scholarship is expressly granted for the two years of Baccalaureate (1st and 2nd). After finishing 1st year of Baccalaureate, the Pupils who benefit from the scholarship must have achieved an excellent academic record to continue enjoying it..
- **2.** Those candidates who renounce an aid will not be able to apply for it again.
- **3.** Pupils who are beneficiaries of the scholarship who are sanctioned by the School in accordance with the provisions of the ECI Behaviour Policy will irrevocably lose the right to the scholarship.
