Manuel Ramírez del Águila was born in El Burgo (Málaga) in 1947, although his personal and family life takes place in Seville. He graduated in Philosophy and Letters (Philosophy and Educational Science Field) at the University of Granada.

He held a firm teaching vocation and taught Philosophy and Latin initially, to later develop his professional career as Headmaster at the Marcelo Spínola School (Umbrete) and at the Alminar School (Dos Hermanas), as well as taking part in multiple cultural activities. In the academic year 2005-2006, he was appointed Headmaster of The English Centre and established the guidelines of our current School. He ended his career leaving a profound mark on the institution thanks to his professional excellence and his involvement with the entire Educational Community.

An avid reader, he loved music and sport, stood out for his kind heart and for all he did for those he knew as well as for those he didn't.

He passed away in Seville in the year 2014, leaving us the best legacy: a love for teaching.

1. ORGANISED BY

2. GENRE

Short story.

Papers must be original and a maximum of five pages and minimum of two (one side only), font: Arial 12, and must include a title.

Only one entry can be submitted per author.

Entry implies acceptance of all the rules and failure to comply may result in disqualification.

3. LANGUAGE

Papers to be submitted in Spanish

4. SUBJECT

Subject of choice.

5. PARTICIPANTS

All pupils enrolled in private, state-subsidised and state schools can individually take part in this contest.

Category A.-Secondary: Years 1, 2 and 3 pupils.

Category B.- Secondary Year: 4 and Sixth Form pupils.

Category C.- The English Centre Secondary and Sixth Form pupils.

Category D.- The English Centre Primary pupils.

Category E.- Pupils with Spanish as second language.

6. PRIZES

The following prizes are established for each Category:

9. ENTRY PERIOD

The submission period will remain open until Friday the 5th of May 2023.

10. RESULTS

The jury's decision, which will previously be communicated to the winners, admits no appeal and will be made public on Friday 2nd of June, via the School website. The jury may declare a prize vacant should they consider it necessary due to poor literary quality.

The prize-giving dates will be communicated to all participating schools, as well as individually to all winners. The organisers can include any changes they consider necessary in order to facilitate the competition process.
